




MEDICAL UNIVERSITY - PLEVEN Bulgaria

LOCATION

Bulgaria is located in southeastern Europe, in the heart of the Balkan Peninsula, bordering Romania (north, via the Danube River), Serbia and the Republic of Macedonia (west), Greece and Turkey (southeast) and the Black Sea (east).

LANGUAGE

- Bulgarian is the native and the official language of the country. Popular foreign languages spoken here include English, German, French and Russian.
- A contribution of Bulgaria to human culture is the Cyrillic alphabet, developed in 9th century for the Orthodox Slavic population in Europe.
- With the accession of Bulgaria to the EU in 2007, Cyrillic became the 3rd official alphabet of the EU.

CLIMATE

The climate is temperate-continental with four distinct seasons: cold winter, changeable spring, hot summer, mild and pleasant autumn, and plenty of sun all year round.

RELIGION

The religious structure of the community is as follows: 85% Eastern Orthodox Christians, 13% Muslims, and minority groups of Roman Catholics, Jews and Protestants.

There are many museums, galleries, theater, cinema, concert halls and dancing clubs.




MEDICAL UNIVERSITY - PLEVEN

Medical University-Pleven was established in 1974. It is a state regulated, self-governed, accredited university.


The University offers high quality education in the fields of Medicine and Health Care.

ADVANTAGES OF STUDYING AT MEDICAL UNIVERSITY - PLEVEN

• Medical University-Pleven has proved to be one of the leading institutions for education in Medicine in Bulgaria.

• The University provides educational and therapeutic facilities required for undergraduate, postgraduate and continuous medical education.



ADVANTAGES OF STUDYING AT MEDICAL UNIVERSITY - PLEVEN

• MU-Pleven is the first to implement English-medium course of study in Bulgaria (1997).

• The University welcomes growing number of students from diverse cultures and nationalities.

• Currently at Medical University - Pleven are studying about 500 international students from 35 countries.



ADVANTAGES OF STUDYING AT MEDICAL UNIVERSITY - PLEVEN

- The clinical training in Medicine is organized in small groups of maximum 8 students, with better practical exposure
- The University hospital, founded in 1865, has 1000 beds in specialized clinics. Research units with modern equipment are also available.



ADVANTAGES OF STUDYING AT MEDICAL UNIVERSITY - PLEVEN

- Medical students can attend lectures and seminars at the newly-established Telecommunication Endoscopy Centre for Robotic Surgery which is included in the structure of MU-Pleven and the University Hospital.
- This is the first specialized center of its kind in Bulgaria and on the Balkan Peninsula. The Center has two modern auditoria, direct video conferencing facility, an experimental operation room and virtual self-educational system for endoscopic surgery training.



Telecommunication Endoscopic Center for training

- MU-Pleven aims to be the first university in Eastern Europe to broadcast 3D live minimally-invasive/robotic operations for training purposes for undergraduate and post-graduate medical students.
- First for Bulgaria live 3D transmission of an onco-gynecological robotic operation was demonstrated in 2013.

Academic year

The academic year for international students starts in February.

It consists of two semesters of 16 weeks each. Each semester ends with an examination session lasting from 30 to 45 days.

The academic year includes two one-week holidays for Christmas and Bulgarian Easter period.

There is summer vacation from 15 July to 10 September.

The basic language of instruction for international students is English.

During the first three years of program foreign students study Bulgarian in order to be able to communicate with patients.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Various modern teaching methods are implemented in the academic process: theoretical lectures, small-group practical tutorials and seminars, clinical practices. Additionally, students may join extracurricular teaching courses and scientific circles functioning at different departments.

Practical Human Anatomy classes are conducted with cadavers in specialized halls.

Class attendance is mandatory.

The program and curriculum are regularly renewed by a special Commission for Methodology and Education, which discusses the new tendencies in medical education in other universities and proposes changes in the curriculum.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Methods of assessment include oral examination, written examination, multiple choice tests, practical skills assessment.

Students are evaluated on a **scale from 2 to 6**.

Grades are based upon tests, assignments, projects, mid-term examinations, final examinations, class attendance and participation. Faculty members inform students of their grading policy at the beginning of each semester.

Summative assessments are conducted at the end of each semester within the examination session.

State licensing examinations (theoretical and practical) are held after completion of the full course of study – year six.

Six grade scale:


Excellent (6) being the highest possible and the lowest positive Satisfactory (3)

Conferences

Since 2001, the students at Medical University - Pleven organize annual International Medical Scientific Conference for Students and Young Doctors. The conferences attract young people from all over the world. They provide young people with an opportunity to exchange ideas and to get involved with research early into their medical study.

Sports facilities at Medical University-Pleven enable the students to implement regular physical training in various sports. Outdoor activities include: athletics, football, tennis, and skiing. The ski trips in winter are a favorite option among the students.



HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION



The University hostel consists of two buildings with 400 beds. The hostel rooms are double- and triple-bedded with adjoining bathrooms and central heating. Students are not obliged to live in hostels and may stay at private accommodations as well.

FOOD AND CATERING

The students' canteen near the hostel provides meals at a discount. There are also numerous fast food bars close to the University and the hospital. The students' club has its own bar with video and sound systems, offering a friendly and cheerful atmosphere.
